

# Excel VBA UserForms

12-hour course

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Design a UserForm tailored to the needs and workflow of their organization.
- Implement a five-step process for creating a UserForm.
- Enhance the UserForm with labels, text boxes, buttons, drop-down menus, list boxes, spin buttons, scroll bars, option buttons, check boxes, images, pop-up calendars and more.
- Write “event driven” VBA code to retrieve data from / save data to the spreadsheet.
- Design, create, program, and troubleshoot a UserForm project of their choosing.
